In Maths, the children have been battling angles! Protractors at the ready! They have been super stars and persevered even when the learning has been really tricky.

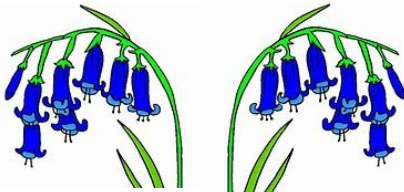
We have also been thinking about what the word 'culture' means and the children have been busy creating their own tribes. Ask them to tell you all about them, they had great fun!
