UNIFORM REMINDERS:

If children are unable to take their earrings out, then parents will need to sign a form acknowledging the acceptance of any risk of injury as a result of wearing these during physical activity. Make up, nail varnish and tattoos should not be worn and hair should not be dyed. We encourage children with long hair to keep it tied up during the school day. It must be tied up for PE lessons.
