Badgers

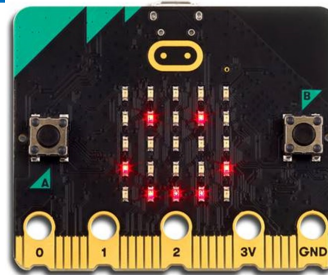
